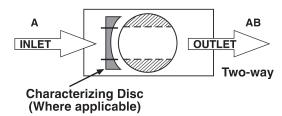

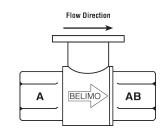
Product features

Two built-in auxiliary switches (2x SPDT), for end position indication, interlock control, fan startup, etc. Solly connect common to negative (-) leg of control circuits.

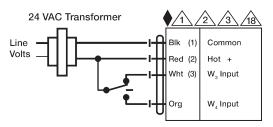

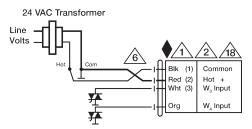

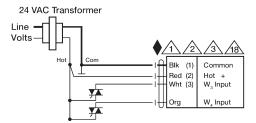
