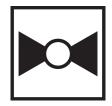

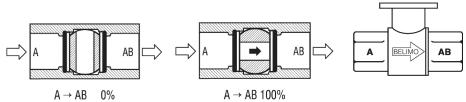

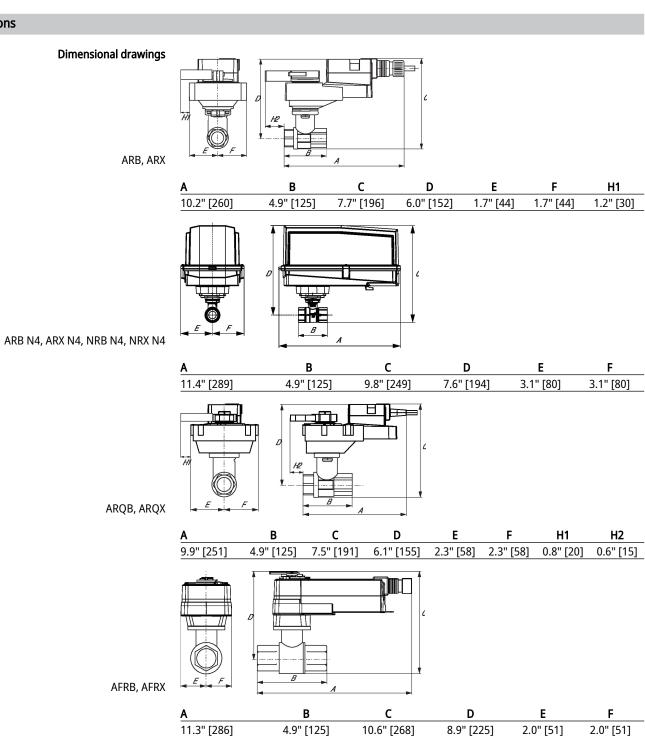


## Flow/Mounting details

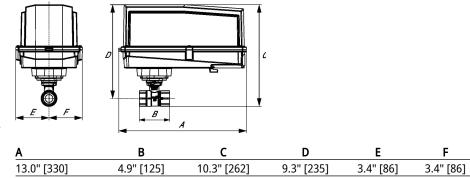


Two-way valves should be installed with the disc upstream.

Apply only AC line voltage or only UL-Class 2 voltage to the terminals of auxiliary switches.

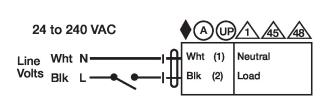

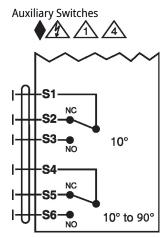
